- Act respectfully, professionally, safely and with kindness toward our clients, their pets and their homes.
- Occasionally boarding a pet or two in their home would be a big plus, but not a requirement.

All our Wranglers are Independent Contractors. Our pet sitting / dog walking opportunities start as part-time and may progress to full-time. Because our clients enjoy the consistency and peace of mind a regular sitter provides, if you are in-between jobs and looking for temporary employment, this is not for you. Schedules will vary with some weeks being very busy (holidays, etc.) and others slower

We serve several counties throughout the North Georgia area and prefer our wranglers to live within 8-10 miles of their assigned pets. A shorter commute results in better service to our clients and more visits per day for our Wranglers.

Responsibilities & Requirements include (but not limited to):

- Professionalism is key! A kind, respectful attitude is a must and casual, neat attire required
- Absolutely NO phone calls/texting during walks unless an emergency, to ensure yours and the pet's safety
- Be able to work consistently during the day and available during nights and weekends
- Have a flexible schedule - pet sitting schedules can, and often do, change daily
- Enjoy being outdoors – may include inclement weather (rain gear encouraged)
- Be able to handle the physical requirements of walking dogs safely
- Own and maintain a reliable vehicle and live within our service areas.
- Be able to clearly communicate verbally and in writing, with Furs Responders' staff and clients
- Be 21 years or older and willing to undergo a criminal background check
- Have access to the internet and a smart phone 24 hours a day
- May include (but not limited to) - Clean up after, groom, exercise and provide care for cats, dogs and other pets as needed. Includes dog walking services, litter box and cage cleaning.
- Observe outdoor and indoor play to ensure safety of the pet
- The ability to follow detailed instructions provided by the client
- Perform and initial "Paws n' Claws Shake" (meet & greet) with potential clients to gain trust and create a relationship with their pet.
- Respect clients' homes and personal property while performing services. May include, but not limited to, cleaning up pet messes. Leave the home as good or better that you found it.
- Provide additional customer service as requested by clients, which may include picking up mail, watering plants and opening and closing blinds or curtains

Pay and Benefits:

When a pet wrangler / dog walker joins our team, they become a valued professional. As such, this position is for pet lovers who want long-term employment in the professional pet field. A deep love of all animals and experience with dogs and cats is required.

Payment for services is 50% of fees charged to clients and 60% on overnight stays, based on our most current fee schedule listed on our website <https://fursresponders.com/pricing>
